SUBJECT: Department of Defense Property in the Custody of Contractors
DD Form 1662

1. References:

- a. FAR 45.505-14, subject: Reports of Government Property
- b. DFARS 245.505-14 subject: Reports of Government Property.
- c. AFARS 5145.505-14 subject: Reports of Government Property
- d. DD Form 1662, DFARS 252.303-1662
- e. DOD 4161.2-M, December 1991, subject: DOD Manual for the Performance of Contract Property Administration.

2. Purpose: In accordance with references 1.a., 1.b., and 1.c., the purpose of this memorandum is to provide a reminder for the **FY 02** submission of subject forms (reference 1.d.) for all DOD contracts administered by the Army. *This pertains to those contracts for which the Army is performing contract property administration and has not delegated the effort to other services (Defense Contract Management Agency (DCMA), Navy, or Air Force).*

3 Scope: Subject forms apply to:

- a. All Department of Defense contract property accountable to and administered by Army.
- b. All property used in the performance of a contract for which the Government has taken title.

4. Background:

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a. Contractors possessing Government property are responsible for preparing DD Forms 1662 as prescribed in FAR 45.505-14 and referenced FAR supplements. Loaned or leased Government property and Government property accountable to a prime contract, but located at a subcontractor's plant or an alternate location, must be included.

b. The data reported should be as of 30 September 2002. Contractors submit DD Forms 1662 to the appropriate Government representative (Property Administrator or contracting officer) no later than 31 October. DD Forms 1662 for contracts administered by the Army are due to the U.S. Army Materiel Systems Analysis Activity (AMSAA) by 5 November each year (AFARS 5145.505-14 (1)) (reference 1.c.). The AMSAA monitors, reviews, corrects, and compiles, DD Form 1662 data to the DOD automated system for consolidation to Congress. The DD Forms 1662 for Army contracts administered by DCMA or the other Services are similarly processed through those channels. Once the DOD report is completed, AMSAA sends complete extract summaries, by contract number, to HQ Army commands/activities and to HQ Department of the Army (DA) IAW AFARS 5145.505-14 (90).

c. Recent GAO and AAA findings have identified problems with commands not properly accounting for Government furnished property in their general ledgers. Some of the figures for reporting to DOD maybe used to satisfy the Chief Financial Officers Act. *Because of such use of the data, you must ensure accurate data is provided. Late submissions (after 5 November) will be reported to HQ DA.*

d. FAR 45 updates and proposed changes are posted at <http://web2.deskbook.osd.mil/default.asp>. It is recommended that personnel performing Property Administration become familiar with those changes as they occur. Check the Army Acquisition Website <http://acqnet.saalt.army.mil/library/default.htm> for the FAR and subparts as they change.

5. Concept

a. Normally the contractor's property control records constitute the Government's official property records (reference FAR 45.105 and FAR

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45.505). If, pursuant to FAR 45.105(b.), the Government elects to maintain the official property records, the clause in FAR 52.245-1, Property Records must be included in the contract. As specified in AFARS 5145.505: "When the contractor's property control records are not used as the Government's official records, the Property Administrator shall maintain the records specified in FAR 45.505, DFARS 245.505 and DOD 4161.2-M that are necessary for maintaining effective property control, to include the DD Form 1662." In this case, the appointed Government representative completes the DD Form 1662, not the contractor.

b. Property Administrators (PAs) are responsible for ensuring that the contractor's property control system provides for reasonably accurate preparation, contractor validation, and timely submission of DD Form 1662. When there are indications of cost and quantity data errors, the Property Administrator should request Defense Contract Audit Agency assistance to perform detailed analysis to determine the extent of the deficiencies. In reviewing the contractor's report preparation process, the Property Administrator responsibilities are outlined in reference 1.e., paragraph L.

c. In addition, the contractor's property control records must provide basic information for every item of Government property in the contractor's possession as described in FAR 45.505-1, Basic Information.

6. Requests:

a. The Contract Property Management System (CPMS) was redesigned to incorporate an Electronic Data submission capability for contractors or the Government PA/POC. IAW AFARS 5145.505-14 (1) each Government PA or designated POC should immediately contact assigned contractors and make them aware of this electronic option. The Army's goal is to have all contractors submit their reports electronically. Although use of the automated programs are optional for contractors, PAs should strongly encourage their contractors to participate in the electronic submission program. All this requires is a logon/password to the system. Both the contractor and Government PA or responsible POC must apply for a logon/password.

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The Government PA/POC will view and approve the contractor's input. If the contractor does not participate in this automated effort, it is the responsibility of each Government command/activity to ensure that they delegate a POC to apply for the logon and input directly their contract property data as received from the contractor. Please notify the AMSAA POC identified for this action by e-mail with specifics. AMSAA will monitor that effort for the Army. The request for password must be done ASAP to allow for at least 30 days for processing of the request and assignment of the logon password by DCMA. Forms can be mailed or faxed to the AMSAA POC. See AMSAA home page (Contractor electronic DD Forms 1662 Data Submission) <http://amsaa.ria.army.mil/IB/govprop/index.html> for instructions regarding the logon request form. Use of the Electronic Data input via WEB eliminates the need for hard copies to be provided to AMSAA. Processing has been determined to be about a 15-minute effort for each DD Form 1662 once on-line. The web site identifies those individuals with WEB access as of the date posted. Those with logons last year may require the AMSAA POC to reset the password.

b. In those rare cases where logon is not feasible and time does not allow, it is requested that one hard copy DD Form 1662 (reference 1.d.) be submitted. For those not participating in the direct input provide a transmittal memorandum. Include the justification for not using the electronic input, point of contact, telephone number, complete mailing address, and E-mail addresses. Last year a number of DD Forms 1662 were provided via e-mail as an attachment with data and form provided. This worked out extremely well and hopefully will continue for this year. All that is needed is software like Form Flow or other compatible software. For those contracts, which the Army still retains, the official records (FAR 52.245.1), please annotate the DD Form 1662 in the signature block or block 9 when using the automated CPMS system. Each HQ contracting office is provided a listing of their contracts as submitted for FY01 which do require a new DD Form 1662 to either update or zero out (encl 1). In addition, for new contracts that have identified Government-Furnished Property, a DD Form 1662 must be prepared and provided. See the AMSAA Web site for instruction on electronic submission of the data.

The listing also identifies those contracts that are still delinquent on last years (FY01) DD Forms 1662 submission requirements. Each contracting office is responsible for the complete dissemination of this

requirement and responsible for ensuring all the DD Forms 1662 are submitted as required. The request to provide this data individually (reference 1c) or as a consolidated submission for FY 02 is acceptable as long as it still meets the 5 November timeframe to this Activity. When additional information is available HQ DA will notify you of this requirement. With the Army's proposed force structure reductions and base closure and realignment actions, contract transfer and responsibility must be maintained. Please notify this Activity of any contract and/or organizational transfers in order to maintain proper accountability and command responsibility.

c. During the FY 01 input cycle; many problems were encountered with the submission of DD Forms 1662. The errors included incorrect contract numbers, missing and incorrect purpose codes and business codes, incomplete names and addresses in blocks 1 and 2, many mathematical errors, missing or inaccurate cage codes in block 2, and incorrect classification of property into categories. Note that each of the categories identified on the DD Form 1662 (blocks 10 through 18) are a specific type of property and should not be duplicated in any other block (see paragraph 6d for the DD Form 1662 Instructions/Examples, dated August 2001). Note that DFARS changes to the definition of Industrial Plant Equipment (IPE) were published in the 1991 editions of the DFARS (DFARS 245.301). The IPE now means, "plant equipment in Federal stock group 34 with an acquisition cost of \$15,000 or more." Please ensure that block 13 reflects the correct category based on the DFARS changes. Emphasis this year must be placed on ensuring that all of the required data is provided correctly and completely.

d. Many requests have been received for blank copies of DD Form 1662. Forms can also be found through the use of Internet under the web page <http://web1.whs.osd.mil/icdhome/DDEFORMS.HTM>. The only requirement is you must have Delrina Formflow or some compatible software.

e. Instructions for the annual requirements of the DD Form 1662/ electronic data input and Government contract property management/disposal information are available on the AMSAA homepage <http://amsaa.ria.army.mil/IB/govprop/index.html>. If you do not have access to the World Wide Web/Internet and or e-mail, call and a hard copy of the instructions can be provided. Upon request, on-site assistance can be provided in contract property management or preparation of the DD Forms 1662.

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f. Changes within the Department of Army and Army Materiel Command have resulted in the reorganization of this activity. See Army Acquisition Circular #96-4, Subpart 45 for the corrected address changes.
